<u>Jesus is God in flesh. He created you. Only</u> <u>He can recreate you. He created everything,</u> <u>including Satan.</u>

He is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn of all creation. ¹⁶ For **by him all things were created**, in heaven and on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or rulers or authorities—all **things were created through him and for him**. ¹⁷ And he is before all things, and in him all things hold together. **Colossians 1: 15-17**

See also Hebrews 1

In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. ² He was in the beginning with God. ³ All things were made through him, and without him was not any thing made that was made. John 1:1-3

"Worthy are you, our Lord and God, to receive glory and honor and power, **for you created all things**, and by your will they existed and were

created." Revelation 4:11

So the Jews said to him, "You are not yet fifty years old, and have you seen Abraham?" ⁵⁸ Jesus said to them, "Truly, truly, I say to you, **before Abraham was, I am.**" ⁵⁹ So they picked up stones to throw at him, but Jesus hid himself and went out of the temple. John 8:57-59

Therefore, if anyone is **in Christ**, he is a **new creation**. The old has passed away; behold, the new has come. 2 Corinthians 5:17

Jesus is the ONLY way to the Father in Heaven.

Jesus said to him, "I am the way, and the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me. John 14:6

And there is salvation in **no one else**, for there is **no other name** under heaven given among men by which we must be saved. Acts 4:12

Jesus is supreme. He will conquer and rule Earth upon His return!

Then I saw heaven opened, and behold, a white horse! The one sitting on it is called Faithful and True, and in righteousness he judges and makes war. ¹² His eyes are like a flame of fire, and on his head are many diadems, and he has a name written that no one knows but himself. ¹³ He is clothed in a robe dipped in blood, and the name by which he is called is The Word of God. ¹⁴ And the armies of heaven, arrayed in fine linen, white and pure, were following him on white horses. ¹⁵ From his mouth comes a sharp sword with which to strike down the nations, and he will rule them with a rod of iron. He will tread the winepress of the fury of the wrath of God the Almighty. ¹⁶ On his robe and on his thigh he has a name written, King of kings and Lord of lords. Revelation 19:11-16

Jesus is the Son of God.

For to us a child is born, to us a **son** is given; and the government shall be upon his shoulder, and his name shall be called Wonderful Counselor, **Mighty God**, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace. **Isaiah 9:6**

And the angel [Gabriel] said to her, "Do not be afraid, Mary, for you have found favor with God. ³¹ And behold, you will conceive in your womb and bear a **son**, and you shall call his name **Jesus**. ³² He will be great and will be called **the Son of the Most High**. And the Lord God will give to him the throne of his father David, ³³ and **he will reign** over the house of Jacob **forever**, and of his kingdom there will be no end." **Luke 1:30-33**

Jesus is the Son of God (continued)

Therefore the Jews sought the more to kill him, because he not only had broken the sabbath, but said also that **God was his Father**, making himself equal with God. John 5:18

And we know that the **Son of God** has come and has given us understanding, so that we may know him who is true; and we are in him who is true, in **his Son Jesus Christ**. He is the true God and eternal life. **1 John 5:20**

And whenever the unclean spirits saw him, they fell down before him and cried out, "You are **the Son of God**." Mark 3:11

Jesus and the Father are One. The trinity is true. Father, Son, and Holy Spirit are One God in three persons.

Just because the word "trinity" doesn't appear in the Bible doesn't mean the trinity isn't present throughout the Bible. The Bible never says "Jesus Loves Me" either, but we can reason from scripture that Jesus loves us because He died for us while we were enemies with God.

In the beginning, **God** created the heavens and the earth. ² The earth was without form and void, and darkness was over the face of the deep. And the **Spirit** of God was hovering over the face of the waters. **Genesis 1:1-2**

Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the **Father** and of the **Son** and of the **Holy Spirit**, **Matthew 28:19**

And the angel [Gabriel] answered her, "The **Holy Spirit** will come upon you, and the power of **the Most High** will overshadow you; therefore the child to be born will be called holy—the **Son** of God. **Luke1:35**

Now when all the people were baptized, and when Jesus also had been baptized and was praying, the heavens were opened, ²² and the **Holy Spirit** descended on him in bodily form, like a dove; and a **voice came from heaven**, "You are my beloved **Son**; with you I am well pleased." **Luke 3:21-22**

"I and the Father are one." John 10:30

And this is eternal life, that they know you, the **only true God**, and **Jesus Christ** whom you have sent. **John 17:3**

"that they may all be **one**, **just as you**, **Father**, **are in me**, **and I** in you, that they also may be in us, so that the world may believe that you have sent me. John 17:21

But Peter said, "Ananias, why has Satan filled your heart to lie to the **Holy Spirit** and to keep back for yourself part of the proceeds of the land?...You have not lied to man but to **God**." **Acts 5:3-5**

There is one body and **one Spirit**—just as you were called to the one hope that belongs to your call—⁵ **one Lord**, one faith, one baptism, ⁶ **one God and Father** of all, who is over all and through all and in all. Ephesians 4:4-6

We are saved by God's grace, not by our own good deeds.

Good works can't pay for sin. Even if our good deeds could outweigh our bad, we have no way of knowing if we've done enough good. God is a loving Father who wants us to be sure of our salvation.

For by grace you have been saved through faith. And this is not your own doing; it is the gift of God, ⁹ not a result of works, so that no one may boast. Ephesians 2:8-9
